- Item 1. Chairman Garrison called the meeting to order at 3:35 pm.
- Item 2. Approve the Minutes from the June 12, 2024 MPO Policy Board Meeting

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve the June 12, 2024 MPO Policy Board meeting minutes. Mayor Bowling made a motion with a second from Chairman Long. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 3. Open Public Comment Period for the Final 2025 Unified Planning Work Program

Chairman Garrison opened a Public Comment Period for the Final 2025 Unified Planning Work Program. With no comments made Chairman Garrison asked for a motion to close the comment period. Mayor Bowling made a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. Chairman Garrison closed the Public Comment Period.

Item 4. Adopt Resolution 24 – 37 to approve the Final 2025 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Mr. Hellums explained that the 2025 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) contains the work tasks and budget to be conducted by the MPO staff for Fiscal Year

2025. Mr. Hellums explained that there were a few comments regarding the draft document from ALDOT and all comments were reviewed and updated.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 37. Mayor Goodwin made a motion with a second by Chairman Long. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 5. Adopt Resolution 24–38 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Reconstruction of SR-684 (Church Street) from Somerville Road to SR-3 (US-31/6th Avenue) in the City of Decatur

Mr. Hellums stated that this is a new project to continue repairing and repaving Church Street from Somerville Road to US 31/6th Street. The Preliminary Engineering will start in FY 25 and the Utilities and Construction is estimated to start in FY 26. The MPO will be responsible for 80% and the City of Decatur will be responsible for 20%.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 38. Councilman Ladner made a motion with a second from Mayor Bowling. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 6. Adopt Resolution 24–39 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Resurfacing on SR-24 from the Morgan County Line to SR-67

Mr. Hellums stated that this project is a state funded project to resurface SR-24 and is scheduled for FY 25. This project will use 80% federal funding and the state will pay the 20% match.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 39. Chairman Long made a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 7. Adopt Resolution 24–40 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Resurfacing on SR-20 (US-72) from Kirby Road to the Morgan County Line

Mr. Hellums stated this is a project to resurface SR-20 from Kirby Road to the Morgan County Line and is scheduled for FY 25. This project will use 80% federal funding and the state will pay the 20% match.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 40. Chairman Long made a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 8. Adopt Resolution 24–41 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Resurfacing on SR-67 from CR-41 to SR-24

Mr. Hellums stated this project is to resurface SR-67 from CR-41(Danville Road) to SR-24 and is scheduled for FY 25. This project will use 80% federal funding and the state will pay the 20% match.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 41. Mayor Bowling made a motion with a second from Chairman Long. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 9. Adopt Resolution 24–42 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Resurfacing on SR-67 from SR-3 (US-31) to CR-41

Mr. Hellums stated that this project is to resurface SR-67 from US-31(6^{th} Ave) to CR-41(Danville Rd) and is scheduled for FY 2025. This project will use 80% federal funding and the state will pay the 20% match.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 42. Mayor Bowling made a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 10. Adopt Resolution 24 – 43 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

RR Crossing Improvements for the Install of Two Cantilevers with LED Signal Flashing Lights, Two Gates, Two Bells, Add One Set of Signal Heads Facing Each

Bike Approaches, Signs, Markers, Legends on Moulton Street at DOT No.352093T in Decatur, CSX RR.REF. NO.1605

Mr. Hellums stated that this project is to replace and improve the equipment at the railroad crossing on Moulton St. near downtown Decatur. This is a 100% federal funding project with no match needed.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 43. Mayor Bowling made a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 11. Adopt Resolution 24–44 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase funding on the following project:

Bridge Replacement BINS 006153 and 001391 on SR-3 (US-31) over Norfolk Southern Railway

Mr. Hellums explained that this resolution is for an increase in cost for the utility phase of the project. The Original Estimated Cost was \$1,250,000.00 with an increased cost of \$131,225.54 for a new Total Cost of \$1,381,225.54. This project will use 80% federal funding and the state will pay the 20% match.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 44. Mayor Bowling made a motion with a second from Chairman Long. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 12. Adopt Resolution 24–45 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase funding on the following project:

Bridge Replacement BINS 006153 and 001391 on SR-3 (US-31) over Norfolk Southern Railway

Mr. Hellums explained that this resolution is for an increase in cost for the construction phase of the project. The Original Estimated Cost was \$7,390,581.00 with an increased cost of \$1,889,183.61 for a new Total Cost of \$9,279,764.61. This project will use 80% federal funding and the state will pay the 20% match.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 45. Mayor Bowling made a motion with a second from Mayor Goodwin. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 13. Adopt Resolution 24–46 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase funding on the following project:

Advanced Corridor Management TSMO on I-65 from SR-67 (MP 332.721) to SR-3 (US-31) (MP 354.753)

Mr. Hellums explained that this project is for traffic message signs along I-65 and I-565. This resolution is for an increase in construction cost. The Original Estimated Cost was \$4,195,891.00 with an increased cost of \$289,818.90 for a new Total Cost of \$4,485,709.90. This project will use 80% federal funding and the state will pay the 20% match.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 46. Mayor Bowling made a motion with a second from Chairman Long. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 14. Adopt Resolution 24–47 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase the Preliminary Engineering funding on the following project:

Intersection Improvements on Vaughn Bridge Road at SR-3 (US-31)

Mr. Hellums explained that this is an increase in cost due to an overrun on the Preliminary Engineering phase of the project. The Original Cost Estimate was \$100,000.00 with an Increase Cost of \$35,045.00 for a Total Cost of \$135,045.00. This project will use 80% federal funding and the City of Hartselle will pay the 20% match.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 24 - 47. Chairman Long made a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. The motion carried unanimously.

 ROW ongoing. Letting expected FY 2025.
- Hartselle ATRIP project on 31. Construction is 30% complete.
- Hartselle TAP grant in downtown is 30% complete.
- Priceville resurfacing has started.
- Priceville TAP grant to install sidewalks along Upper River Rd and Bethel Rd.
 Design is ongoing.
- Decatur 6th Ave project is waiting on final permits.
- Decatur Causeway Lighting Project has let and contractor has been selected.
- Decatur ATRIP II project at Upper River Rd and AL 67 intersection. Design is underway. ROW ongoing. Scheduled letting 2025.
- Decatur TAP grant to update sidewalks on 6th Ave. Permits are approved. Waiting to bid.
- Morgan County culvert project. ROW ongoing.
- Trinity ATRIP II project at S Greenway DR and AL 24. Design is 90% complete. Scheduled letting later FY 2025.
- I-65 TISMO project to install message boards and traffic cameras from Priceville to Athens. Design is 65% complete.
- I-65 bridge replacement in Lacon over Flint Creek and railroad. Design is 30% complete. Schedule letting FY 2025.
- I-65 resurfacing project is in the preliminary design phase.
- I-65 sign replacement project is in the preliminary design phase.
- I-65 Tennessee River Bridge repair and painting project ongoing. Project is estimated to be 50% complete.
- Norfolk Southern Railroad Bridge crossing in south Limestone County. Design is 90% complete. ROW ongoing. Scheduled letting later FY 2024.
- AL 20 resurfacing project in Decatur is ongoing.

Mr. Hellums updated the board on the status of the new 2050 Traffic Demand Model. He informed the board that the MPO staff will present the new demographic data for the MPO area.

WHEREAS, the Decatur Metropolitan Planning Organization in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration, the Federal Transit Administration, and the Alabama Department of Transportation has reviewed all requirements to adopt Safety Performance Management Targets for use in the transportation planning process; and

WHEREAS, the Technical Coordinating Committee at its February 27, 2025 meeting recommends that the Policy Board support the Performance Management (PM1) Targets approved by the Alabama Department of Transportation as follows:
